Getting Ready

Buffer time during hair and makeup allows the photographer to begin capturing images during the final stages of getting ready, while ensuring the bridal party is dressed, on schedule, and able to arrive on time without feeling rushed.

Grouping photos intentionally reduces stress and allows you to stay present instead of being pulled away from your wedding day.

Reception Flow

- Cocktail hour
- Dinner
- Toasts
- First dances
- Sunset note

If your reception takes place near sunset, timing is especially important – Florida sunsets are brief and easily missed, so a short, intentional pause allows you to capture those iconic moments before the light fades.

Morning Wedding Timeline

This timeline is a relaxed guide – beach conditions, tides, and light are always respected for the best experience.

- **Vendor Arrival**

- Your BWD vendors arrive at your wedding site ready for your big day.

- **Setup Windows**

- The set-up times are 1-3 hours prior to the start of your ceremony.

- **Getting-Ready Buffer**

- Wedding couples should be ready 1 1/2 hours prior to scheduled ceremony time.

- **Ceremony Start**

Guests and the wedding couple are encouraged to arrive early to allow a smooth ceremony start.

- **Photo Flow**

- Photo flow is relaxed and guided, with moments captured before, during, and after the ceremony.

Afternoon & Golden Hour Timeline

This timeline is a relaxed guide – beach conditions, tides, and light are always respected for the best experience.

- Arrival + Décor

- Your BWDs team arrive 1-3 hours prior to your scheduled time.

- Ceremony (approx. 15 minutes)

- Your ceremony includes vows, sand ceremony, ring exchange, first kiss, BWDs officiant & photographer.

- Family Photos

- Family photos are completed efficiently, allowing time for relaxed couple portraits.

- Couple Portraits (approx. 30 minutes or less)

- The wedding couple with guided intimate photos as planned.

- Sunset Buffer (VERY important in SWFL)

Natural light and photography flow together to capture a warm Florida skyline during golden hour.

Sunset / Evening Timeline

This timeline is a relaxed guide – beach conditions, tides, and light are always respected for the best experience.

- Lighting Considerations
- Ceremony and portraits are timed to capture the best natural light as sunset conditions shift.
 - Cocktail Hour Flow
 - Guests transition comfortably into cocktail hour while the couple enjoys relaxed portraits nearby.
 - Reception Transition *
 - The celebration continues seamlessly as the evening transitions into reception time or relaxed guest gathering.
 - Exit timing *
- At reception, photos of your entrance, dance, cake & lifestyle images are taken as planned.
